



## THE CHRIS JENKINS ARCHIVE

Acquired November 2020 from Totnes, Devon

Archive on acquisition stored in 50+ large cardboard boxes with multiple document wallets or other files, or loose papers, in each. Whole archive was in quite poor condition, suffering from damp/mould damage and damage caused by mice. Most of the archive contained photocopied articles.
